BA (Years 1-3)

- Understand and respond fittingly to what they read and encounter
- Delight in and value the diversity of language
- Recognize the significance and relevance of literature and culture.

The MA program's primary advantage is its adaptability, allowing students to demonstrate their abilities without penalizing them for errors.

Considering English's current status as a global language and the crucial need for effective communication, analysis, and critical thinking, the skills acquired during the 5-years parcourse are highly sought after by universities and employers alike.
