Division 01: Law.

- Training objectives: pedagogical, scientific, development-related objectives: the training in this division has a very large specificity, as it aims to develop the student's methodological and objective skills and abilities in the field of public and private law.

As well as preparing qualified administrative cadres to assume Professional Responsibility in their fields of competence, and openness to the components of the social and economic fabric in order to exchange experiences with actors in other sectors.

The composition in this master includes the following main research axes:

- The central and Main articles in public law such as the law of Public Utilities, comparative constitutional law, the law of territorial groups, the law of administrative contracts...

- Deepen the study of the subject of fundamental rights and freedoms and try to link them with practical aspects and the reality of their practice.

- Providing students with basic legal knowledge and skills related to administrative law in its modern dimensions, such as the economic dimension (economic control authorities).

- In-depth study of some disputable applications in public law, such as constitutional disputes and tax disputes, focusing on practical and analytical aspects under the new legal texts.

- Target competencies, student exit profile and professions:

During the course, the student will receive multiple training in the field of Legal Sciences, considering that each subject has rules and principles governing it, and through theoretical training and guided work, the student will acquire skills and techniques in the field of Legal Sciences, and this theoretical and Applied Information will be supplemented by training in foreign languages and automated media.
