





Solo, more formally known as Surakarta, lies in the center of Javanese culture in the province of Central Java. The city is well connected to other cities in Indonesia with extensive bus, train, and air links.

In 2020, the Association of Planning Experts' survey voted Solo as the most liveable city in Indonesia. This recognition comes as no surprise to Solo residents who live in a diverse and peaceful environment. In addition, Solo is also popular for its safety and cleanliness.

Solo is calm city away from crowded metropolitan area. Living in Solo provides an access to witness historical remains and distinguished culture of the heritage city. Solo is also a place of opposites, where the traditional way of life is highly interwoven with the urban style coloring the atmosphere of the. Complete modern facilities of the city do not eliminate the long established local identity of Javanese tones in every beat of day-to-day activities of the city. Traditional market stand still accompanied by modern malls, two historical palaces, Kasunan and Mangkunegaran, show their glorious past in contrast to modern iconic architectures, not to mention various cultural festivals that are open to broad audience every year. 


The low cost of living in the city adds the convenience. Many people consider living in Solo cheaper than living anywhere else in Indonesia.

### ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR UNS SCHOLARSHIP

Applicants must:

- Be non-Indonesian citizens (those who hold Indonesian citizenships are not eligible)
- Show a strong interest in seeking a full-time degree program at UNS
- Be willing and able to attend an interview over a video call
- Be at maximum of 22 years old by July 2021 (for bachelor program)

### COVERAGE OF UNS SCHOLARSHIP

At the moment, UNS Scholarship only covers tuition fee waiver and does not assist with any other fees/costs. Students are thoroughly responsible for all fees and expenses such as airfare, visas and immigration fees, accommodation, meal, transportation, daily living cost, health insurance, and other personal expenses. The scholarship is given in the form of tuition fee waiver, meaning that students will not receive cash from UNS

### RESPONSIBILITY OF UNS SCHOLARSHIP Awardee

All awardees of UNS Scholarship must:

- comply with Indonesian laws and regulations, university's regulations, and other associated regulations
- attend all lectures and academic activities held by university, study program, and faculty
- achieve minimum GPA 2.00 in every semester
- finish their study on time



### TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF UNS SCHOLARSHIP

UNS scholarship is granted with the following terms and conditions:

- The scholarship is given for 8 semesters for bachelor program, 4 semesters for master program, and 6 semesters for doctoral program. Awardee has to pay the tuition fee if they cannot finish their study after the scholarship has reached the duration.
- The scholarship can be terminated if awardee cannot maintain minimum GPA or violates the regulation of university and Indonesian law.
- Transfer to other study program or faculty is not allowed.
- Awardee who resigns from UNS have to pay back the tuition fee waiver that has been granted.

- Medical statement (in English or Indonesian language)

- Financial statement
- Personal statement
- Certificate of Indonesian language proficiency (optional but strongly preferred)
- Certificate of English language proficiency (obligatory for master and doctoral degree)
- Letter of recommendation #1, from a lecturer/professor or work supervisor (only for master and doctor degree)
- Letter of recommendation #2, from a lecturer/professor or work supervisor (only for master and doctoral degree)
- Preliminary research proposal to be developed into a dissertation (only for doctoral degree)



## ADMISSION PROCEDURE

Student candidates are required to follow the procedure below for international student admission at UNS:

- Prospective students learn and look for the study program that fits their interest.
- Student candidates prepare the required documents.
- Student candidates submit an online application by filling out an online form.
- Student candidates submit all the required documents at the "Upload Document" section on the online application.
- Student candidates print a registration card after submitting the required documents.
- Administrative selection will be conducted by the admission committee.
- Interview selection will be conducted for student candidates who pass the administrative selection.
- Successful candidates will be notified by email, along with the Letter of Acceptance.
- Student candidates send confirmation to study at UNS.
- Admitted students complete online registration as student at UNS academic website.
- Admitted students come to UNS upon receiving notification from UNS International Office.



- Be willing and able to attend an interview session in Indonesia or over a video call



## Terms and Conditions:

- The grantee is required to maintain a minimum Grade Point of Average (GPA) 2.75 out of 4.0
- The university could terminate the scholarship if grantee is failed to maintain satisfactory academic progress and/or violate the univesity rules.
- The grantee should repay the scholarship if he/she decides to terminate before the completion of the program


